Requirements

- ii. Minimum of 2 years working experience in marketing, community relations, or similar roles (preferably in sports, education, NGOs, or governmental sectors);
- iii. Working experience in planning, organizing and leading camp/ training programs is an advantage;
- iv. Excellent communication, interpersonal and organizational skills; highly selfmotivated;
- v. Demonstrated knowledge in marketing skills, digital tools, social media management and multimedia production;
- vi. Proficiency in written and spoken Chinese and English.

Responsibilities

- (A) Promotion & Publicity
 - 1. Assist in developing and implementing marketing strategies and initiatives to enhance public awareness and understanding.
 - 2. Enhance brand visibility through managing content development across social media, newsletters and website platforms.
 - 3. Develop and maintain social media platforms.
 - 4. Analyse promotional data regularly to assess and improve effectiveness.

 - 2. Organize and coordinate staff training and workshops focused on social media management and maintenance.
 - 3. Prepare reports and presentations for potential partners and customers, and maintain effective working relationships with internal and external stakeholders.
